California School Employees Association "CSEA" and District Management "District" negotiation teams have mutually composed, reviewed and approved this communication.

We are pleased to announced a tentative agreement was reached for 2019-2020 by the California School Employees Association (CSEA) and the Rocklin Unified School District. Below are the details.

The agreement will now be submitted first to the union membership for a ratification vote and then to the RUSD Board of Trustees for approval. There are more than 350 outstanding employees represented by CSEAin the Rocklin Unified School District.

RUSD/CSEA Sunshine proposals were approved at the May 1, 2019 meeting. The following items were opened:

The teams met on May 7, 2019 and May 13, 2019. A tentative agreement on the listed articles was signed on May 13, 2019 pending ratification.
