TENTATIVE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN ROCKLIN TEACHERS PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION AND THE ROCKLIN UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

May 29, 2009

- 1. The Association will commit to the reduction of four (4) contract days; conditioned upon the District rescinding at least 80% of final notices and agreeing that no August layoffs will occur.
- 2. Revenue beyond what is needed to maintain positions for the 2009-10 school year will be utilized to address either mid year reductions to the 2009-10 budget or to be able to continue the district's contribution to programs and staffing added back to the budget in 2009-10 for the 2010-11 year.
- 3. Three (3) of the four (4) furlough days will be from the staff development days. The 4th day will be the last contract day of the year.
- 4. The three (3) staff development furlough days will be combined with the two (2) President's holidays to provide a continuous week of non work time.
- 5. Both parties agree to meet on or before February 1, 2010 with the intent of reassessing the budgetary situation.
- 6. The final terms and conditions of this agreement will be for one year (2009-10).
- 7. The salary schedules in effect for the 2009-10 year reflecting a reduction of 4 paid days are attached as Appendices A and B.
